

# COMPONENTS IN THE TABLE ROWS OF TOTAL INCOME AND FAMILY AVERAGE MONTHLY BUDGET VARIATION

## Initial Observations:

- This document presents the product codes for the components of each row in the total income and family average monthly budget variation.
- Each code with 5 digits was composed from 2 digits of the variables “chart number” and the 3 first digits of the variable “item code”.
- The 2 last digits of the variable “Item Code” refer to sequential numbers, used to identify synonyms or different regional denominations of a same product. Since these sequentials are aggregated into one single code in the table’s construction, they needn’t be described in the table’s rows.

## Total income and Budget Variation - 1 + 2

### 1 – Total income - 1.1 + 1.2 + 1.3 + 1.4 + 1.5

#### 1.1 – Income from work - 1.1.1 + 1.1.2 + 1.1.3

1.1.1 - Employee – 53001 a 53004, 54015 a 54018, 54020, 54036 a 54038, 55001 a 55002, 55011, 55026, 55035, 55037 a 55043, 55045, 55062 a 55063

1.1.2 - Employer – 53005, 55003

1.1.3 – Self-Employed – 53006

#### 1.2 - Transfers - 1.2.1 + 1.2.2 + 1.2.3 + 1.2.4 + 1.2.5 + 1.2.6

1.2.1 – INSS retirement wage and pension – 54001 a 54002, 55022 a 55023, 55064

1.2.2 – Public pension fund retirement wage and pension – 54003 a 54004, 55065

1.2.3 – Private pension fund retirement wage and pension - 54005, 54023, 55025, 55033, 55066

1.2.4 – Federal social programs – 54010 a 54012, 54024

1.2.5 – Alimentary pension, allowance and donations – 54007, 54026, 54032, 55030

1.2.6 – Other transfers– 54006, 54013 a 54014, 54019, 54021 a 54022, 54025, 54027 a 54031, 54035, 55017 a 55018, 55029, 55031, 55055 a 55059

**1.3 – Income from rent - 54008 a 54009**

**1.4 – Other income – 54033 a 54034, 55004, 55007, 55009, 55012 a 55013, 55015 a 55016, 55019 a 55021, 55024, 55027 a 55028, 55032, 55034, 55036, 55046 a 55052, 55054**

**1.5 – Non-Monetary Income**

1 – Sum all values referent to non-monetary expenses (when means of acquisition is set between 7 and 11), except values in code 10090.

2 – Subtract from the referred value of code 10090 the values of all monetary expenses (when means of acquisition is set between 1 and 6) in the following codes:

Code of chart 8 – 08001 to 08017, 08019 to 08072 and 08077 to 08999

Code of chart 10 – 10005, 10010, 10012 to 10013

Code of chart 12 – 12005 to 12025, 12030 to 12033 and 12999

Consider only when difference is positive (> 0).

3 - Final Result: (1+2).

**2 – Budget Variation – Sum of codes 55005 a 55006, 55008, 55010, 55014, 55044 + for each set of data the following differences:**

Código 57001 – Código 56001 (only if > 0)

Código 57002 – Código 56002 (only if > 0)

Código 57003 – Código 56003 (only if > 0)

Código 57004 – Código 56004 (only if > 0)
